- * The Tuition Fee includes the University of Chester Fees.
(For **re-submission** of failed essays an additional fee of £100 per 20 credits will be payable)
For on-site students tuition is charged at the year of entry prices, provided there is no more than one year of interrupted studies.
- ** **The Board & Lodge Fee includes the cost of a short-term Missions Trip** (excluding spending money). A fee of £130 is required on arrival as the deposit for your room, fob and key. This is refundable if the room and key are returned in good condition at the end of the year and if all other debts owed to the College have been paid.
Board and Lodge fees cover the use of a room and all facilities during term time for the academic year. With regards to board, the weekend ministry placements are designed to run from Friday-Sunday. All on-site food, etc, directly related to your ministry placement are to be provided by your placement church. If you are at your home church, then all related costs will be covered by yourself. Any contribution that the church makes will be a private arrangement between you and the church.
- *** **The Facilities Fee includes the cost of a short-term Missions Trip** (excluding spending money). The Facilities Fee allows day students to make use of all College facilities (excluding student accommodation). It also includes the provision of lunch during the working week Monday - Friday.
- Application & Acceptance Fees** When submitting an application for any course, a non-refundable fee of **£15** is payable. Upon acceptance onto the course the following fees apply:
DBS fee - residential/day students (payable at interview) - **£50**
Acceptance fee - Residential, Day Students and Distance Learning Students - **£50** (offset against the first year's fees)

Application & Acceptance Fees

When submitting an application for any course, a non-refundable fee of **£15** is payable.

Upon acceptance onto the course the following fees apply:

*Acceptance Fee - **£200**

*All new first-year Post Graduate students are required to pay an acceptance fee of £200 upon acceptance, in order to hold their place on the course. These will be offset against the first year's fees. From the date of signing and returning the Acceptance Letter, candidates have a fourteen day 'cooling off' period, during which they may cancel the agreement, and receive a full refund of the acceptance fee. After that fourteen-day period, the acceptance fee is non-refundable.

Payment Schedule

Where a student is not in receipt of Student Finance:

50% of the annual fee must be paid by 9 September 2019. A further 25% of the annual fee must be paid by 20 January 2020. The final 25% is to be paid by 27 April 2020.

For further information, contact the college and speak to our finance department.

Where we have evidence that a student is in receipt of student finance, the annual fee is divided into three equal amounts, corresponding to the three termly instalments in which funds are made available to students. Students are expected to make payments as soon as student funding is received.
