Application & Acceptance Fees

When submitting an application for any course, a non-refundable fee of **£15** is payable.

Upon acceptance onto the course the following fees apply:

*Acceptance Fee - **£200**

*All new first-year postgraduate students are required to pay an acceptance fee of £200 upon acceptance, in order to hold their place on the course. These will be offset against the first year's fees. From the date of signing and returning the Acceptance Letter, candidates have a fourteen day 'cooling off' period, during which they may cancel the agreement, and receive a full refund of the acceptance fee. After that fourteen-day period, the acceptance fee is non-refundable.

Payment Schedule

Where a student is not in receipt of Student Finance:

50% of the annual fee must be paid by 7 September 2020. A further 25% of the annual fee must be paid by 18 January 2021. The final 25% is to be paid by 23 April 2021.

For further information, contact the college and speak to our finance department. Where we have evidence that a student is in receipt of student finance, the annual fee is divided into three equal amounts, corresponding to the three termly instalments in which funds are made available to students. Students are expected to make payments as soon as student funding is received.
