Fees for new students:

Full-time, context-based and distance-learning
(Includes validation fees for the University of Chester)

Tuition Fees and Facilities Fees for students studying part-time (two years) will be charged at 55% of the above rate in each year of their study.

Tuition Fees and Facilities Fees for students studying part-time (three years) will be charged at 37.5% of the above rate in each year of their study.

Application & Acceptance Fees

When submitting an application for any course, a non-refundable fee of **£100** is payable. This is made up of a £50 Application Fee and a £50 towards the cost of a DBS check.

Upon acceptance onto the course the following fees apply:

*Acceptance Fee - **£200**

*All new first-year undergraduate students are required to pay an acceptance fee of £200 upon acceptance, in order to hold their place on the course. These will be offset against the first year's fees. From the date of signing and returning the Acceptance Letter, candidates have a fourteen day 'cooling off' period, during which they may cancel the agreement, and receive a full refund of the acceptance fee. After that fourteen-day period, the acceptance fee is non-refundable.

Payment Schedule

Where a student is not in receipt of Student Finance:

50% of the fee must be paid by 2 September 2021. A further 25% of the fee must be paid by 6 January 2022. The final 25% is to be paid by 14 April 2022.

For further information, contact the college and speak to our finance department. Where we have evidence that a student is in receipt of student finance, the fee is divided into three equal amounts, corresponding to the three termly installments in which funds are made available to students. Students are expected to make payments as soon as student funding is received.
